# **Award Nomination Form Instructions**

Please consider nominating a worthy project/organization/individual/group for the 2011 Virginia Statewide Neighborhood Conference Awards Program.

Review the following instructions and criteria carefully:

**STATE NEIGHBORHOOD PROJECT OF THE YEAR**: effort that has made a significant impact on a neighborhood. This project can be the work of an individual or group.

**STATE NEIGHBORHOOD ADVOCATE OF THE YEAR**: individual who has had a significant impact on their community during the past year. Individuals who have participated in one or multiple projects/roles are eligible. Individuals whose service is defined by its longevity are most appropriate for this award.

#### STATE NEIGHBORHOOD YOUTH INDIVIDUAL OR YOUTH GROUP EFFORT OF THE

**YEAR**: effort of an individual youth that has made a significant impact on their community during the past year or a youth group effort that has made a positive contribution to the neighborhood.

Please submit the following information to apply for an award:

- A Completed Nomination Form
- A typed document clearly addressing the following criteria. Please limit answers to each of the following categories to 750 words or less:
  - (1) How the project contributed to the betterment of the neighborhood
  - (2) How the nominee's accomplishments promote strengthening and enhancing neighborhoods or community
  - (3) The positive results/accomplishments of those efforts.
- Letter of Support Do not exceed five (5) letters of support. The letters should explain how the project/organization/individual/group benefited your community.
- Submit up to five (5) attachments that capture the essence of accomplishments (*pamphlets, articles, presentations, photographs, copies of resolutions/awards, etc.*)

**Youth Applicants Only -** In addition to the requirements above, please include a LETTER of endorsement from an <u>adult sponsor</u> or an <u>adult active with the initiative</u>.

The letter should address the following but not exceed two (2) pages:

- 1. How long have you known the youth or have been working with the youth group?
- 2. How did the youth serve in a leadership role? How did the youth group work together to achieve goals?
- 3. What positive accomplishments occurred as a direct result of the youth/youth group effort?
- 4. Did the success exceed your expectations? If so, how?
